Notice is hereby given that the last day to register for the November 6, 2018, State General Election will be **October 9, 2018**.

If you are not currently registered to vote or need to register at a new address, you may do so at the following locations and times:

In Person:

- Southfield Township Clerk's offices 18550 W. 13 Mile Rd. Southfield Township, MI 48025, Monday-Friday 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- County Elections Division, 1200 N. Telegraph Rd., Pontiac, MI 48341, Monday – Friday, 8:00am – 4:30pm.
- Secretary of State Branch Offices.
- At specified agencies for clients receiving services through Family Independence Agency, the Department of Community Health, Michigan Jobs Commission and some offices of the Commission for the Blind.
- At military recruitment offices for persons who are enlisting.

By Mail:

- Voter Registration Application - Mail to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline.

Note: Persons registering by mail are required to vote in person unless they have previously voted in person in the state or are at least 60 years of age or are handicapped.

The election will be conducted in all the actual voting precincts of Southfield Township for the purpose of electing candidates for the following offices, Governor/Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, United States Senator, Representative in Congress 9th District; State Senator 12th District; Representative in State Legislature 35th District; State Board of Education, University of Michigan Regents; Michigan State University Trustee; Governor of Wayne State University; County Commissioner 14th District; Justice of Supreme Court; Judge of Court of Appeals 2nd District- Incumbent Position, Judge of Court of Appeal- 2nd District- Incumbent Position term 01/01/2021; Judge of Circuit Court 6th District- Incumbent Position; Judge of 6th Circuit Court-Non-Incumbent Position; Judge of 6th Circuit -New Judgeship; Judge of Probate Court-Incumbent Position; Judge of 46th District Court- Incumbent Position; Oakland County Community College Trustees; Village of Beverly Hills Council Members; Board Members Birmingham Public Schools; Village of Bingham Farms Council Members; Board Members Southfield Schools; Village of Franklin Clerk; Village of Franklin Trustees, Village of Franklin Library Board Members and the following proposals. Village of Franklin Proposal 1- Shall the Village of Franklin be authorized to construct, provide and maintain an outdoor pedestrian lighting system within the downtown Franklin Road corridor between 14 Mile Rd and Scenic Drive.
