And for the purpose of voting on the following proposals:

STATE PROPOSAL 18-1: A PROPOSED INITIATED LAW TO AUTHORIZE AND LEGALIZE POSSESSION, USE AND CULTIVATION OF MARIJUANA PRODUCTS BY INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER, AND COMMERCIAL SALES OF MARIJUANA THROUGH STATE-LICENSED RETAILERS.

STATE PROPOSAL 18-2: A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION OF CITIZENS WITH EXCLUSIVE AUTHORITY TO ADOPT DISTRICT BOUNDARIES FOR THE MICHIGAN SENATE, MICHIGAN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND U.S. CONGRESS, EVERY TEN YEARS.

STATE PROPOSAL 18-3: A PROPOSAL TO AUTHORIZE AUTOMATIC AND ELECTION DAY VOTER REGISTRATION, NO-REASON ABSENTEE VOTING, AND STRAIGHT PARTY TICKET VOTING; AND ADD CURRENT LEGAL REQUIREMENTS FOR MILITARY AND OVERSEAS VOTING AND POST-ELECTION AUDITS TO THE MICHIGAN CONSTITUTION.

VILLAGE OF BINGHAM FARMS PROPOSITION A: SHALL SECTION 2(1) OF CHAPTER II BE AMENDED TO PROVIDE THAT THE VILLAGE MAY ACQUIRE/OR DISPOSE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OF A VALUE NOT EXCEEDING \$20,000.

SHALL THIS BE ADOPTED?

VILLAGE OF BINGHAM FARMS PROPOSITION B: SHALL SECTION 8(2) OF CHAPTER III OF THE CHARTER BE AMENDED TO PROVIDE THAT THE VILLAGE COUNCIL MAY ESTABLISH AND/OR CONTRACT FOR A POLICE DEPARTMENT.

SHALL THIS BE ADOPTED?

VILLAGE OF BINGHAM FARMS PROPOSITION C: SHALL SECTION 8 (3) OF CHAPTER III OF THE CHARTER BE AMENDED TO ELIMINATE ANY REFERENCE TO THE VILLAGE MARSHALL.

SHALL THIS BE ADOPTED?

VILLAGE BINGHAM FARMS PROPOSITION D: SHALL SECTION 21 OF CHAPTER IV OF THE CHARTER BE AMENDED TO PROVIDE THAT IF THERE IS A CONFLICT BETWEEN THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN AND THE VILLAGE CHARTER WITH RESPECT TO THE ELECTIONS.

SHALL THIS BE ADOPTED?

VILLAGE OF BINGHAM FARMS PROPOSITION E: SHALL SECTION 5 OF CHAPTER VI OF THE CHARTER BE AMENDED TO PROVIDE THAT THE MAXIMUM FINE FOR VIOLATION OF ANY ORDINANCE SHALL BE INCREASED.

SHALL THIS BE ADOPTED?

VILLAGE OF BINGHAM FARMS PROPOSITION F: SHALL SECTION 7 OF CHAPTER IX OF THE CHARTER BE AMENDED TO PROVIDE THAT THE VILLAGE SHALL PROVIDE FINANCIAL REPORTING IN THE MANNER REQUIRED BY THE STATE.

SHALL THIS BE ADOPTED?

VILLAGE OF BINGHAM FARMS PROPOSITION G: SHALL SECTION 11 OF CHAPTER XVI OF THE CHARTER BE AMENDED TO PROVIDE THAT PERSONS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THE CHARTER OR VILLAGE ORDINANCES SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500.00 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS.

SHALL THIS BE ADOPTED?

VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN: PEDESTRIAN LIGHTING FRANKLIN VILLAGE CHARTER CHAPTER XVI REQUIRES VOTER APPROVAL TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION, PROVIDING, OR MAINTENANCE OF A LIGHTING SYSTEM.
