The requirements to be a precinct worker are that you fill out an application, you are 18 or older and a resident of Oakland County. You will be required to attend precinct worker training and become acquainted with the Election Equipment and working as a precinct worker is a very interesting experience.

The following are the dates and times the election equipment will be set up for precinct workers to assemble and dis-assemble and ask questions about the equipment. All day Friday, May 18th and Monday, May 21st from 9 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Tuesday, May 22nd in the **morning only from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.**

I strongly encourage you to make every effort to come and take advantage of this opportunity to learn how the new equipment operates. Additional training will be required and offered as is done before each election but this pre-election opportunity will offer a chance to become more acquainted with the new equipment.
